THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF AJAX

BY-LAW NUMBER 52-2010

GROUP HOME BY-LAW

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, authorizes a municipal council to pass a business licensing By-law for group homes;

AND WHEREAS The Town of Ajax Zoning By-law, as amended, permits the establishment and use of group homes in the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS a public information meeting was held in Council Chambers of the Town of Ajax to discuss the proposed By-law on April 19th, 2010;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Ajax enacts as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

1.1 This By-law may be cited as the Group Home By-law.

2. DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 In this By-law,
 - (a) "Group Home" means group home as defined in Section 163 of the Municipal Act, as amended.
 - (b) "Licence" means a licence issued under the provisions of this By-law.

3. GENERAL

- 3.1 No person shall own or operate a Group Home that is not licensed in accordance with this By-law.
- 3.2 The licencee of a Group Home under this By-law shall have the Licence renewed annually before January 1st of each year.

4. LICENCE APPLICATION

- 4.1 Every applicant for a Licence shall complete a Licence application form provided by the Town of Ajax, and shall include the following:
 - a) a letter from the appropriate federal or provincial agency responsible for funding or licensing the Group Home;
 - b) the annual Licence fee of \$ 25.00.

5. OFFENCE AND PENALTY

5.1 Every person who contravenes any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine or penalty for each offence, exclusive of costs, as prescribed by the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, as amended from time to time.

6. VALIDILITY

6.1 If a Court of competent jurisdiction should declare any section or part of a section of this Bylaw to be invalid, such section or part of a section shall not be construed as having persuaded or influenced Council to pass the remainder of this By-law and it is hereby declared that the remainder of the By-law shall be valid and shall remain in force.
