

Ajax Temporary Emergency Shelter

UPDATE #1

This winter, the Town of Ajax is supporting the Region of Durham by providing Town-owned space at 27 Station Street to temporarily shelter those experiencing homelessness.

The Town of Ajax is sharing information provided by the Region about the number of people receiving services at the emergency shelter to promote transparency.

- Approximately **430** sleeps in December
- Total number of individuals served: **61**
- Average time stayed: **8 nights**
