St. Catherine of Siena Park is getting some upgrades including:

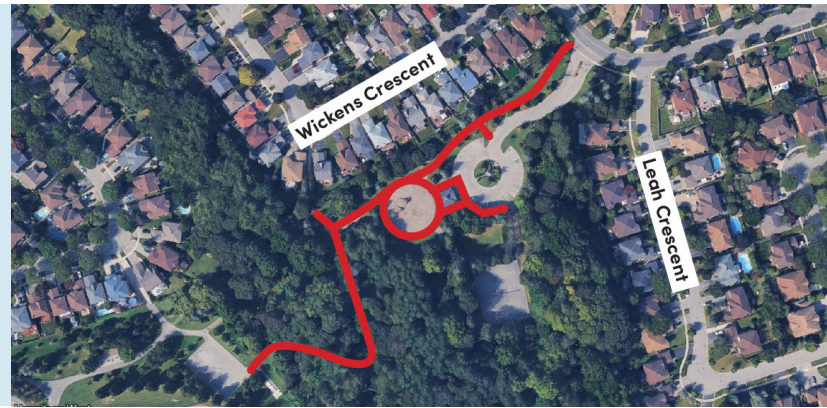


- A new children's playground

Road construction updates

The Regional Municipality of Durham has started work for the first segment of the **Durham-Scarborough Bus Rapid Transit (DSBRT)** construction along Kingston Road from approximately 300 metres west of Harwood Avenue to Galea Drive in the Town of Ajax. Anticipated completion of the work is June 2027. Work will include:

- Construction of dedicated median bus lanes, median transit stop platforms and shelters
- Road reconstruction
- Traffic signals with dedicated bus movements
- Dedicated in-boulevard cycle tracks with crossrides

- Sidewalks with accessibility improvements
- Watermain and sanitary sewer installation
- Street lighting and landscaping

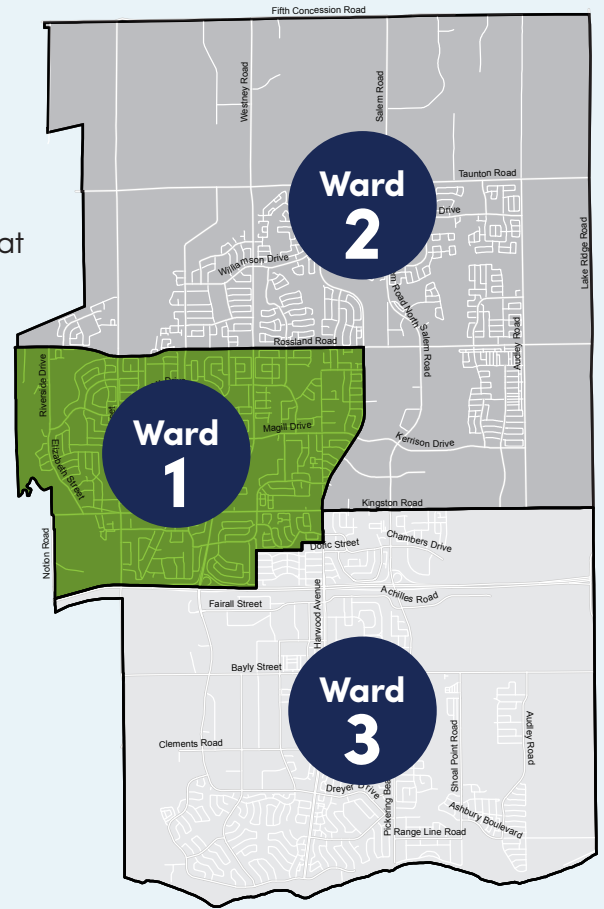
