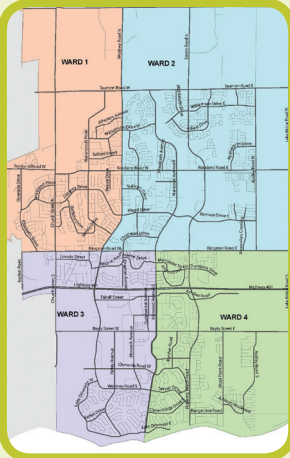


Ajax Ward Boundary Review

To ensure fair and equitable Council representation for Ajax residents, the Town is reviewing the size and shape of Ajax's wards.

5 step guide on how to get involved!



1. WHAT IS A WARD?

A Ward is an identifiable geographic area in Ajax that is represented by a local and regional member of Council. Currently, the Town is divided into four wards – each local councillor represents one ward, each regional councillor represents two wards (one for wards 1 & 2, and one for wards 3 & 4), and the mayor represents the Town at large.

2. NEW: AJAX COUNCIL IS MOVING TO A 3 WARD SYSTEM, WHICH INCLUDES:

- Three local councillors
- Three regional councillors
- The Mayor

7 ward boundary options have been identified.
