

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Campaign of Ashmeed Khan:

Opinion

We have audited the accompanying campaign period financial statements of the candidacy of Ashmeed Khan, which comprise the statement of assets and liabilities as at June 30, 2019 and the income and expenses for the campaign period from May 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019, included in Form 4.

In our opinion, except for the possible impact of the matters described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion Section of the report, the accompanying financial statements of the Campaign for the period ended June 30, 2019 are prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Section 88 of the Municipal Elections Act and the Candidates' Guide for Ontario Municipal Council and School Board Elections.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the inherent nature of the transactions of organizations of this type, the completeness of the various categories of income and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of income and expenses was limited to the amounts recorded in the records of the Campaign and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to income, expenses and period surplus/deficit for the campaign period from May 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019 and assets and liabilities as at June 30, 2019.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements* section of our report. We are independent of the Campaign in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements in Canada, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

Emphasis of Matter – Basis of Accounting and Restriction on Distribution

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with provisions of Section 88 of the Municipal Elections Act and the Candidates' Guide for Ontario Municipal Council and School Board Elections. The financial statements are prepared to assist the Campaign to meet the requirements of Municipal Elections Act. As a result, the financial statements may not be suitable for another purpose. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Responsibilities of Chief Financial Officer of the Ashmeed Khan campaign for the Financial Statements

The chief financial officer of the Ashmeed Khan campaign is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Section 88 of the Municipal Elections Act and the Candidates' Guide for Ontario Municipal Council and School Board Elections and for such internal control as the chief financial officer determines is necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

The Chief Financial Officer is responsible for overseeing the Campaigns financial reporting process.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our qualified opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.


