# Ajax Ward Boundary Review

## Final Recommendations & Adoption of New Ward Boundaries

Ajax Council will consider a final report on recommendations for new ward boundaries. The report will recommend options for new wards that will take effect in the 2018 municipal elections. The Ward Boundary Review is necessary following the approval of one additional seat at Durham Regional Council and subsequent necessary changes to Ajax Council beginning as of the 2018 municipal elections.

The Community Affairs and Planning Committee will meet to receive a final report and determine new ward boundaries for Ajax. Members of the public interested in this matter are invited to attend and may address the Committee to share their comments or questions.
